Day 1: Created in God's Image

Reading: Genesis 1:26-27, Psalm 139:13-16

Day 2: The Breath of Life

Reading: Genesis 2:7, John 20:21-22



Day 3: Stewards of Creation

Reading: Genesis 1:28-30, Psalm 8:3-8

Day 4: Made for Relationship

Reading: Genesis 2:18-25, Ephesians 5:31-33

Marriage, as instituted by God, is a profound picture of Christ's relationship with the Church. Whether married or single, we are all called to reflect God's love in our relationships. Day 5: Restored in Christ

Reading: Romans 5:12-21, 2 Corinthians 5:17-21

Devotional: While sin has marred the image of God in humanity, Christ's redemptive work offers restoration and renewal. Through faith in Jesus, we are being transformed back into the likeness of our Creator. This process of sanctification is ongoing, empowered by the Holy Spirit. As new creations in Christ, we are called to live out our restored identity and to be ambassadors of reconciliation. Today, meditate on the areas of your life where you need Christ's restoring touch. How can you cooperate with the Holy Spirit in this transformative work? Consider how you can be an agent of God's reconciling love in your community.
