I. Introduction to Matthew 6

1. Proper Relationship with Our Emotions and Hearts

- Focus on Jesus' teachings in Matthew 6 about the internal life of the disciple and avoiding external displays of piety for human approval.

II. Breakdown of Matthew 6

1. Charitable Deeds (Matthew 6:1-4)

Key Points:

- Avoid doing charitable deeds for show (Matthew 6:1).
- Do them secretly for God's recognition, not man's (Matthew 6:2-4).



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Cross References:

- 1 Samuel 2:2 - Hannah's prayer as an example of focusing on God.
- James 5:2-3 - Warning about the corrosion of earthly treasures.

2. Prayer (Matthew 6:5-15)

Key Points:

- Pray sincerely, not for public admiration (Matthew 6:5-6).
- Avoid vain repetitions (Matthew 6:7-8).
- Lord's Prayer as a model (Matthew 6:9-13).
- Importance of forgiveness (Matthew 6:14-15).

Cross References:

- Luke 11:1-4 - Parallels to the Lord's Prayer.
- 1 Samuel 2:2 - Hannah's sincere prayer.



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3. Fasting (Matthew 6:16-18)

Key Points:

- Fast without drawing attention to yourself (Matthew 6:16-18).

Cross References:

- 2 Chronicles 20:3 - Jehoshaphat's fasting and seeking God.

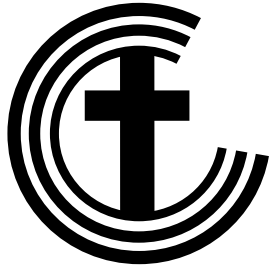
4. Treasures in Heaven (Matthew 6:19-21)

Key Points:

- Store up treasures in heaven, not on earth (Matthew 6:19-21).

Cross References:

- James 5:2-3 - Earthly treasures' temporary nature.



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5. The Lamp of the Body (Matthew 6:22-24)

Key Points:

- The eye as the lamp, guiding light or darkness (Matthew 6:22-23).
- Serving God, not materialism (Matthew 6:24).

Cross References:

- Luke 11:34-36 - The eye as the lamp of the body.
- Luke 16:13 - Cannot serve both God and mammon.

6. Do Not Worry (Matthew 6:25-34)

Key Points:

- God's provision for life's needs eliminates worry (Matthew 6:25-30).
- Seek first God's kingdom (Matthew 6:31-34).



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Cross References:

- Luke 12:22-34 - Parallels on not worrying.
- 1 Samuel 2:2 - Trusting God as in Hannah's example.

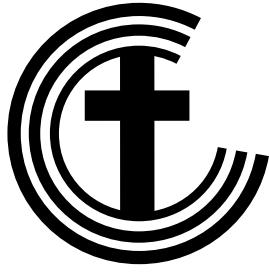
III. Applications and Implications

1. Trust in God's Provision and Focus on Spiritual Growth

- Emphasize the need for reliance on the Holy Spirit and proper understanding of Scripture.

2. Avoiding Legalism and Cultural Conformity
